

### **Summer in School**




Now that we are experiencing warmer weather, please remember that children can wear summer dresses and shorts. They do not need to wear their jumpers in school if they do not wish to.



Also, please remember to send your child with a water bottle so that they can keep hydrated throughout the day. On particularly sunny days, the children should also




