


UKS2 Newsletter - Autumn 1 2023

What are we learning this half term?

Welcome back to school and Autumn term 1. This is a busy term for UKS2 and we have a full term of exciting and important learning for your child.

This half term in maths, we will be recapping number and place value, focusing on rounding, ordering, negative numbers and FDP. In writing, we will be looking at non-chronological reports, moving on to writing letters later in the term. In reading, we will be exploring 'The Tulip Touch'. We will use this text to help us develop key skills, such as retrieval, vocabulary and summarizing.
