


# **UKS2 Newsletter - Spring 1 2024**

## What are we learning this half term?

Welcome to Spring Term 1. We have another busy half term planned with lots of interesting and exciting learning taking place.

In maths we will be focusing on different areas in Years 5 and 6, as our Year 6 children start preparing for SATs. Year 5 will be learning about shape and Year 6 will be learning fractions,

decimals and percentages before moving onto shape. In writing, we will be creating recounts and narratives, focusing on speech punctuation and active and passive voice. In reading, we will be reading 'Goodnight Mister Tom'. We will use this text to help us develop a range of key reading skills.



### **School Uniform and Lost Property**

Our History topic this half term will be Conflict and War. Throughout this exciting topic we will be discussing historical interpretations and question the ethicality of conflicts (namely WW2). We will also explore how conflict has erupted in the past as well as the impact of war on their local area. We will use our new knowledge to understand how knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources.
