
What are we learning this half term?

This half term, in Maths we will be focusing on Measures: learning specifically about length, weight and capacity. We will also be looking at Perimeter & Area.

In reading this half term, we will be reading Louis Sachar's 'Holes'. We will use this text to help us develop key skills, such as retrieval, inference, deduction, summarizing and quencing.

In our writing this half term, we are writing a mixed genres for a range of audience and purposes. .We will be focusing on vocabulary choices as well as clauses and phrases, prepositions, synonyms and antonyms.

Year 6 will also be working hard throughout the half term with additional SATs practice.



P.E

In P.E this half term, we will be working on Lacrosse & Hockey, Danish Long Ball. Children will also continue sessions with Junior Jam.
