




Curriculum Highlights this half-term.....

As well as all the exciting English and Maths this half term, we will also be finding out about Animals (including humans) in our science lessons across schools, including the skeleton, what we eat and what growing old is like. In History, Key stage 1 will be learning about "London's Burning". LKS2 will be investigating Stone Age to Iron Age and UKS2 will be finding out about the Greeks and their impact on Britain. Our Art work this half term is going to focus on drawing skills. Music is going to continue to play an important part in this year's learning and children will be continuing to sing and compose music across the school. Children in Key Stage 2 will still be learning a musical instrument. The Djembe (drum) in Year 3, further percussion instruments in Year 4 and Year 5 and 6 will continue to learn how to play the Ukulele. It's going to be action-packed!
