Diwali



Diwali is a very important religious celebration that takes place every year. Although it is traditionally celebrated by Hindus and Sikhs, it can be celebrated by people from other religions as well. The specific date of Diwali varies but it is between the months of October and November each year. This year it was celebrated on 4th November.

In Hinduism, this festival of lights, takes place over 5 days and is enjoyed by children because of the lights, fireworks and sweets involved. Oil lamps are lit to help the goddess of wealth, Lakshmi, find her way into people's homes. Diwali celebrates the return of Rama and Sita back to Rama's Kingdom. The festival marks the victory of good over evil and light over darkness. Rangoli patterns are drawn on the floor, usually including a lotus flower, as Lakshmi is associated with this flower.

For Sikh's, Diwali is really important as it celebrates the release of the 6th guru, Guru Hargobind and 52 princes in 1619. Sikh's light the golden temple to celebrate the guru's return. Diwali is known as the 'festival of lights' because shops, public places and homes are decorated with small oil lamps called diyas. Fireworks are a huge part of the celebrations and people also get together and exchange gifts.
