## Attendance Matters

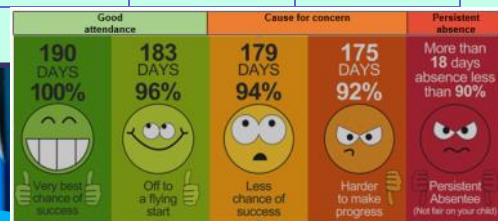
Whole school attendance is **94%** this week.
