

English For our literacy we are focusing on stories related to the new topic "Lets Celebrate This includes stories such as 'Bonfire', 'Diwali', 'Room on the broom', 'Celebrations around the world', 'Scaredy Squirrel', 'The Christmas story, and many more exciting tales that grasp the children's interest in reading. We will be continuing with different writing formats and start using the learning high frequency words and sounds to write phrases and sentences. This then continues with the mark making and reading opportunities allowing the children to use the learned sounds in Rocket Phonics for opportunities to explain writing as well as read to their audience. We are also going to look at the 'Pass the Jam Jim' in depth to focus on pupils understanding of text.



PSHE

PSHE During the half term children will focus on the importance of celebrating familiar and new events in relation to our school cultures. This will be in link with the Jig-Saw strategies we introduce to the pupils. This half term we shall be informing pupils of 'Celebrations!'.

Maths

Maths We shall continue learning about our number systems and compositions of numbers of to ten; continuous counting in 10s; and recognising simple patterns of natural objects. Children will able to use real life objects as part of their role play to enhance their vocabulary and problem solving skills. This will then lead to explanation of their reasoning and development of individual thought processes. Songs and specific tasks will help to explain their learning, as well as visual, playful, activities in all areas of provision.



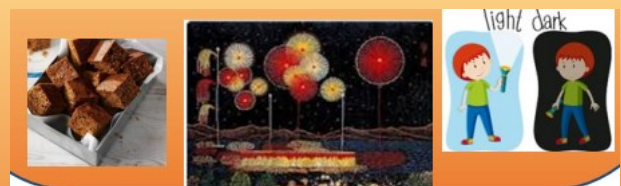
Homework
