# What are we learning this half term?

This half term, in Maths, Year 5 will be focusing on Statistics, Algebra and Fractions. Our arithmetic work will focus on percentages and addition and subtraction. Year 6 will continue with revision work in preparation for their SATs.

In reading this half term, Year 6 will continue reading Michael Morpurgo's 'Friend or Foe'. Year 5 and 6 will also be reading Polly Ho-Yen's 'Boy in the Tower'. We will use these texts to help us develop key skills, such as retrieval, inference, deduction, summarizing and sequencing.

In our writing this half term, we are writing short writes, including third person, character descriptions and non-chronological reports. SPaG will focus on plural nouns and comparative and superlative adjectives.



## History, Geography and Science

We will begin a new topic in History this half term:

The Industrial Revolution. The children will be focusing on what lead to the Industrial Revolution, what changed during the Industrial Revolution and what changes ere implemented because of the problems that arose during this period of time.

In Science we will be focusing on Life Cycles and be able to describe the differences between a mammal, a bird, an amphibian and an insect. They will also look at the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.
