What happens if my child is absent from school?

Stage 1 Below 96%

Stage 1 letter sent home. Attendance is monitored for 2 weeks.

Stage 2 Below 94%

Stage 2 letter is sent home and you are invited in for a meeting to discuss the support we can offer. An Attendance Support Plan will be created at the meeting.

Stage 3 Below 92%

Stage 3 letter is sent home. You will be invited in to meet with Senior Leaders to review the Attendance Support Plan. You may be asked to provide evidence to support the schools decision about whether to authorise any future absence.

Stage 4 Below 90% - Persistently Absent

We will refer you to the Local Authority's Attendance Improvement Officer. They will support you to improve your child's attendance. If it does not improve, they will progress to legal intervention.

Stage 5 Below 80% - LEGAL

The Local Authority will use one of the following options:

Issue a penalty notice. Non payment of a penalty notice can lead to prosecution through a Magistrates Court and a **fine of up to £1000.**

Apply to the Family Court for an Education Supervision Order.

Apply directly to the Magistrates Court for a **fine of up to £2500** and/or a Community Rehabilitation Order, **or a custodial sentence of up to 3 months.**
