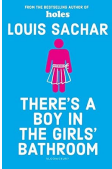


What we are learning this half term

	MATHS: Place Value, Rounding, Ordering, Negative numbers, Fractions Decimals and Percentages and building their fluency skills in arithmetic.
	WRITING: This half term the children will use their skills to write instructions and letters. There will also be focus on grammar and spellings.
	NOVEL: There's A Boy in the Girl's Bathroom by Louis Sachar. The children will read the text and answer comprehensions questions based on the book.
	SCIENCE: This half term the children are going to be looking at the developmental changes in a human right from before they are born all the way to when they are old.
	HISTORY: The children will be learning about the Ancient Greek daily life, food, houses and buildings, trade; including how did they travel and what they were trading, Greek belief systems, festivals and Gods, inventions and achievements and the lasting impact of the Greek on civilization.
	COMPUTING: This half term, we will be focusing on developing the knowledge of online safety.
	PE: This half term, children will be developing their skills in football, circuits and cross country.
	RE: This half term, the children will study how and why Jewish festivals are celebrated today.
	PSHE: Children will identify goals for the forthcoming year and understand group dynamics, the right to feel welcome and valued and how behaviour affects groups.
	ART: This half term, the children will be looking at the artist Peter Randall Page and focusing on their drawing skills.

P.E

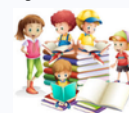
